MVL-TC Symposium Subcommittee Meeting Minutes

May 20, 2016

The meeting began at 12:30

- 1. Welcome The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. He outlined the agenda.
- 2. Reports
  - a. ISMVL-2015 V. Gaudet reported on last year's symposium. There were 52 paid attendees and 3 complimentary attendees (invited speakers). The surplus was about 2,700 Canadian dollars (2,000 US dollars). It was also reported that the surplus (higher tax) will has to be paid to the IEEE Computer Society from ISMVL 2017, but TCs and sponsored conferences will be allowed to carry over part of their surpluses to subsequent years.
  - b. ISMVL-2016 T. Hanyu reported on the current symposium. There are 82 paid attendees and 4 complimentary attendees (invited speakers). External funding has been provided by several Foundations.

Y. Yuminaka reported on the technical program which has 45 contributed papers selected from 67 submissions by 64 reviewers. There are 4 invited speakers and a special session. He is planning 2 special issues on MVL in the Journal of MVLSC and the IEICE Transactions on Information and Systems.

M. Natsui reported on the finances of ISMVL 2016 that the total amount of income is about \$64,000, the total amount of outcome including money paid to the IEEE CS is about \$56,000, and the surplus is about \$8,000.

- 3. Future Events
  - a. ISMVL-2017 The 2017 symposium will be held on May 22 to 24 in Novi Sad, Serbia as approved at the 2015 Plenary Session. J. Pantović and R. Stanković will serve as Symposium Co-Chairs, and E. Dubrova, F. Manyà, and S. Nagayama will serve as Program Co-Chairs. Pantović noted that the location of the symposium will be in a building at University of Novi Sad. She is planning to hold a special sub-symposium tribute to Tvan Stojmenović in the ISMVL-2017.



- b. ULSI-2017 J. Pantović reported that the workshop would follow the same format as in 2016 and previous years, and it will be held on May 21, 2017 (before ISMVL-2017).
- c. RM-2017 J. Pantović reported that the workshop would follow the same format as in 2015, and it will be held on May 24-25, 2017 (after ISMVL-2017).
- 4. Site Proposal for ISMVL-2018 R. Wille presented a proposal to host ISMVL-2018 in Linz, Austria. He noted that Linz is easily reached by air from major European airports. Linz is about 150KM from Vienna, and it is easily reached by train. There are many hotels with very reasonable prices. The plan is to hold the symposium in May, 2018. He is planning to hold a PhD Forum in the ISMVL-2018, and also planning to invite some people in other research area as Program co-chairs.

The proposal was very well received.

5. Other Proposals

C. Winstead presented a proposal to host ISMVL-2019 in Salt Lake City, Utah, USA. The TC policy that proposals are not approved more than two years in advance was noted.

6. There being no other business, the meeting concluded at 13:20.
