Guide-Line of the Camera-Ready Manuscript for JS-MVL 2001

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Abstract—In this guide-line, the detailed format of the final camera-ready manuscript is shown. As the proceedings will be issued on "Camera Ready Manuscript" basis with the size of A4, you have to read the following guide-line carefully before you make your camera-ready manuscript.

1. Introduction

The Second Korea-Japan Joint Symposium on Multiple-Valued Logic (JS-MVL2001) will be held on August 27–29, 2001 at Aoshima Palm Beach Hotel, Miyazaki, Japan. In this guide-line, I show how to write the final camera-ready manuscript to submit the JS-MVL2001. Please read this carefully and make your final manuscript.

2. Paper, Length and Margin

Please use the A4 size paper and print one side of the paper only. The total length of the manuscript should be within 4 pages. If exceeded, the page charge (10,000 YEN/page) is required. All margins (top, bottom, left and right margines) of the manuscript are the same and the value is 25 mm except for **the top margin of the first page is 35 mm**.

3. Style of the First Page

The followings are required in the first page of your manuscript accordingly.

- (1) Title (at center of the top line)
- (2) Name of the authors at the center
- (3) Affiliations and e-mail at the center
- (4) Abstract (100 to 150 words, single column format)
- (5) Body (see next chapter)

The format of this guide-line is the recommended first page.

4. Type Setting for the Body

The followings are required in the body of the manuscript.

- (1) Double columns format.
- (2) Use 10 point size type and the typeface of times or times new roman, do not use fancy fonts.
- (3) You can attach any Figures, Graphs or Photos in any place of the manuscript as far as they sit within the margins above.

5. Submission

The final manuscript that is satisfied the above conditions should be submit via e-mail or the postal mail.

5.1 Submission via e-mail

If you submit via e-mail, you should prepare the PDF file of the final camera-ready manuscript and send to me as the attached file by July 25, 2001. The e-mail address is
