It was agreed that J. Paseka and E. Zaitseva should be nominated. The selection will take place at the plenary session.
5. **MVL Journals** – M. Lukac reported that 11 papers were submitted to the special issue in the Journal of Applied Logics (JALs) for ISMVL 2021, and 7 papers were accepted. He is also planning to have a special issue in the JALs for ISMVL 2022. Its submission deadline is Aug. 25, 2022.
