It was agreed that R. Miyauchi and D. MacFarlane should be nominated. The selection will take place at the plenary session.
5. **MVL Journals** – M. Lukac reported that he is planning to have three kinds of special issues in the JMVLS, the JALs, and the IEICE for ISMVL 2023. Their submission deadlines will be announced by individual CFPs.
