The meeting began at 12:30

1. **Welcome** – The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. He outlined the agenda.
2. **TC Activities (Budget)** – The Chair reported that major uses of the budget: 3 awards, proceedings for ISMVL, travel cost to attend TAC meeting, and Student Travel Grants.
3. **Awards** – The following award winners were proposed and were approved unanimously online:
 - a. **Outstanding Contribution Paper Award:** Ken Asano, Masanori Natsui, and Takahiro Hanyu, “Write-Energy Relaxation of MTJ-Based Quantized Neural-Network Hardware”
 - b. **Long Term Contribution Award:** Milena Stanković
 - c. **Kenneth C. Smith Early Career Award in Microelectronics:** No nomination this time.
4. **Nominations for Two members-at-large** – Two members-at-large are required for the executive subcommittee to replace M. Behrisch and T. Araki whose terms end at the end of December 2024. It was agreed that K. Podlaski and T. Hirayama should be nominated. The selection will take place at the plenary session.
5. **MVL Journals** – M. Lukac reported that he is planning to have two kinds of special issues dedicated to honor the memory of Kenneth C. Smith in the JMVLS and the JALs. Since the special session dedicated for KC Smith is planning to be held in ISMVL 2025, delaying the Special issues to next year to synchronize with the special session was proposed. However, since the special issue of the JMVLS has been begun, and we cannot stop it, only the special issue of JALs was decided to delay to the next year. Thus, in JALs, the special issue for ISMVL 2024 will be planned as usual. Their submission deadlines will be announced by individual CFPs.
