ISMVL-2016 Plenary Session Minutes

May 20, 2016

Sapporo, Japan

Chair: V. Gaudet, MVL-TC Chair

Present: ISMVL-2016 Attendees

The meeting began at 15:20.

1. **Welcome** – The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. He outlined the agenda.
2. **Chair's Remarks** – The Chair noted the 2016 TC budget is based on the financial outcome of ISMVL-2014. There is funding for student travel awards. The budget for 2017 will be the same as for 2015.
3. **ISMVL-2015** – There were 55 participants including 3 invited speakers. The budget is showing a surplus of 2,700 CAD. ISMVL-2015 is officially closed.
4. **ISMVL-2016** – The Symposium Chair reported that there were 82 paid attendees. 64 of 67 submitted papers were accepted and there were 4 invited addresses. The total amount of income was about \$64,000, the total amount of outcome will be about \$56,000, and the surplus will be about \$8,000.
5. **ULSI-2016** – There were three invited talks, 2 regular papers and 9 student papers. There were 47 participants. The workshop chair of ULSI-2017 is M. Natsui.
6. **RC-2016** – The 8th Conference on Reversible Computation will be held in Bologna, Italy, July 7-8, 2016.
7. **ISMVL-2017** – ISMVL will be held in Novi Sad, Serbia on May 22-24, 2017. ULSI workshop will be held on May 21, and RM workshop will be held on May 24-25. J. Pantović outlined the plans and arrangements for ISMVL-2017.
8. **RM-2017** – The 2017 Reed-Muller workshop will be held the day after ISMVL-2017. The Chair R. Stanković called for paper submissions.
9. **ISMVL-2018** - R. Wille presented the proposal to host ISMVL-2018 in Linz, Austria. He noted that Linz is easily reached by air from major European airports. Linz is about 150KM from Vienna, and it is easily reached by train. There are many hotels with very reasonable prices. The plan is to hold the symposium in May, 2018. He is planning to hold a PhD Forum in the ISMVL-2018, and also planning to invite some people in other research area as Program co-chairs.

The recommendation of the MVL-TC Executive Subcommittee to hold ISMVL-2018 in Linz was unanimously approved.

10. **MVL-TC Executive** – The Chair advised that the Executive Subcommittee nominees for three year terms as members-at-large to begin January 1, 2017 are M. Soeken and N. Onizawa. There were no further nominations so both were acclaimed.
