ISMVL-2023 Plenary Session Minutes

Matsue, Japan

The meeting began at 11:35 (JST).

1. **Welcome** – The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting, and encouraged everyone to join the TCMVL. She outlined the agenda.
2. **Awards** – The Chair reported the award winners as follows:
 - a. **Outstanding Contributed Award:** Mike Behrisch, “Weak Bases for Boolean Relational Clones Revisited”
 - b. **Long Term Contributed Award:** Rolf Drechsler
 - c. **KC Smith Early Career Award in Microelectronics:** Takashi Hirayama
3. **Nominations for Members at Large** – The Chair advised that the Executive Subcommittee nominees for three year terms as members-at-large to begin January 1, 2024 are Ryoichi Miyauchi and Duncan MacFarlane. There were no further nominations, so both were acclaimed.

4. **MVL Journals** –M. Lukac reported that he is planning to have three kinds of special issues in the JMVLS, the JALS, and the IEICE for ISMVL 2023. Their submission deadlines will be announced by individual CFPs.

5. **ISMVL-2022** – The Symposium Chair, M. Thornton, and the Program Chair, K. Smith, reported on the last year’s ISMVL that 29 of 42 submitted papers were accepted (acceptance rate: 67%) and there were 3 invited addresses. There were 65 registrants.
6. **ISMVL-2024** – J. Paseka reported that the 54th symposium would be held on May 28 to 30 at Masaryk University in Brno, Czech Republic as approved at the 2022 Plenary Session. J. Paseka will serve as Symposium Chair and M. Behrisch & Y. Yuminaka will serve as Program Chairs. He noted that there are many flights from countries in Euro, but the Vienna airport would be more convenient than the Prague airport.
7. **ULSIWS-2023 & ULSIWS-2024** – The workshop chair, Y. Iijima, reported that the workshop was held on May 21, 2023. There were four regular talks and 11 student posters. 31 people attended the sessions in-person. The best student poster award was given to Mr. Takeshi Senoo. The ULSIWS-2024 will be held just before or after ISMVL-2024 as usual. The General Chair will be Y. Iijima.
8. **ISMVL-2025** – G. Dueck proposed hosting ISMVL-2025 Montreal, Quebec, Canada in May 2025. There are many direct flights from Euro and Asia. The General Chairs will be V. Gaudet and W. Gross. The proposal was approved unanimously.
9. **RMWS-2023** – T. Sasao reported on this year’s workshop. The workshop is going to be held on May 24, 2023 (just after ISMVL 2023). There are 10 regular talks.
10. **ISMVL-2023** – The Symposium Chair, Y. Yuminaka, reported on the current symposium. The number of paper submissions was 51, and 37 papers were accepted (acceptance rate: 72.5%). The number of registrants is 69 and around 60 people attended the symposium in-person. The number of student registrants is 26 (37%). Student Travel Grant is helpful to increase the number of student attendees. It was given to 6 students. The symposium consists of three invited talks, 8 regular sessions, and 2 special sessions.
11. There being no other business, the meeting concluded at 12:25 (JST).
