MVL-TC Symposium Subcommittee Meeting Minutes

May 23, 2019

The meeting began at 12:30

1. Welcome – The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. He outlined the agenda.
2. Reports
 - a. ISMVL-2018 – R. Wille reported on last year’s symposium. The number of paper submissions was 80, and 44 papers were accepted. There were 73 paid attendees.
 - b. ISMVL-2019 – G. Dueck reported on the current symposium. There are 58 registrations. The number of paper submissions was 61, and 38 papers were accepted.
 - c. ULSIWS-2019 – M. Natsui reported on the current workshop. There are 7 regular talks and 25 attendees.
 - d. RM-2019 – M. Thornton reported on the RM workshop 2019. There are 2 invited talks and 5 regular talks. The workshop will be held on May 24, 2019.
3. Future Events
 - a. ISMVL-2020 – The 50th anniversary symposium will be held on May 20 to 22 in Miyazaki, Japan as approved at the 2018 Plenary Session. Y. Hata will serve as Symposium Chair, and Y. Yuminaka will serve as Program Chair. Yuminaka noted that the location of the symposium will be at a hotel in downtown of Miyazaki. They are planning 50th anniversary special events.
 - b. ULSI-2020 – M. Natsui reported that the workshop would follow the same format as in 2019 and previous years, and it will be held on May 19, 2020 (before ISMVL-2020). Student Poster Session is planning. N. Onizawa is proposed as the workshop chair, or co-chairs with M. Natsui. M. Natsui agreed to ask N. Onizawa whether he can be chair or not.
4. Site Proposal for ISMVL-2021 – M. Lukac presented a proposal to host ISMVL-2021 in Nursultan (former name Astana), Kazakhstan. He noted that Nursultan is easily reached by air from main cities

all over the world. He is thinking Nazarbayev University or a hotel as the symposium venue. There are many hotels with very reasonable prices, and we can get the symposium venue by taxi from the airport.

The proposal was very well received.
