1. **Welcome** – The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. He outlined the agenda.

## 2. Reports

- a. **ISMVL-2023** Y. Yuminaka reported on last year's symposium. The number of paper submissions was 51, and 37 papers were accepted (acceptance rate: 72.5%). The symposium had three invited talks, 8 regular sessions, and 2 special sessions. There were 59 attendees inperson, and around 10 online attendees. The accounts for ISMVL2023 were closed in sound condition.
- b. **ISMVL-2024** J. Paseka reported on the current symposium. The number of paper submissions was 42, and 31 papers were accepted (acceptance rate: 73.8%). The number of registrants is around 65 and 55 people attended the symposium in-person. The symposium consists of three invited talks and 11 regular sessions.
- c. **ULSIWS-2024** Y. Iijima reported on this year's workshop. The workshop was held on May 27, 2024. There are 8 regular talks. 20 people attended the Workshop. The best student presentation award will be given to Mr. Kazuho Sakoda.

## 3. Future Events

- a. **ISMVL-2025** V. Gaudet reported that the 55<sup>th</sup> symposium would be held on May 14 to 16 in Montreal, Quebec, Canada as approved at the 2023 Plenary Session. V. Gaudet and W. Gross will serve as Symposium Co-Chairs. Considering current economical situation, they proposed two-day symposium on May 15 16 without excursion (the RM2025 and ULSIWS2025 will be held on May 14) to keep registration fee as low as possible. The style of the symposium will be hybrid (online attendance is just as a backup). The special session dedicated to honor the memory of Kenneth C. Smith is planning. The proposal was approved.
- b. **RM-2025** M. Miller reported that the workshop will be held in the morning on May 14 in a hybrid style (in-person & online). The General Chair will be M. Miller. He said that the

cooperation of young researchers as committee members is needed for sustainable management of the workshop.

- c. ULSIWS-2025 The workshop will be held just before ISMVL-2025 as usual. Since the RM2025 will be held in the morning on May 14, the ULSIWS2025 will be held in the afternoon on May 14. The General Chair will be Y. Iijima.
- 4. **Site Proposal for ISMVL-2026** N. Homma proposed hosting ISMVL-2026 in Sendai, Japan in May 2026. There are many direct flights from Euro and North America. The General Chair will be N. Homma and the Program Chair will be M. Natsui. The proposal was very well received.
- 5. There being no other business, the meeting concluded at 12:30.
