**MVL-TC Symposium Subcommittee Meeting Minutes**

Thursday, June 5, 2025, 12:00 – 12:35

The meeting began at 12:00

1. **Welcome** – The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. He outlined the agenda.

**2. Reports**

- a. **ISMVL-2024** – J. Paseka reported on last year's symposium. The number of paper submissions was 42, and 30 papers were accepted (acceptance rate: 71.4%). The symposium had three invited talks and 11 regular sessions. There were 56 attendees in-person, including 17 students from 11 countries. The accounts for ISMVL2024 were closed in sound condition.
- b. **ISMVL-2025** – W. Gross reported on the current symposium. The number of paper submissions was 45 from 11 countries, and 39 papers were accepted (acceptance rate: 86.7%). The number of registrants is 69 including 15 students from 9 countries. The symposium consists of three invited talks, 6 regular sessions, and 2 special sessions.
- c. **ULSIWS-2025** – Y. Iijima reported on this year's workshop. The workshop was held on June 4, 2025. There were 1 invited talk by Prof. Nakahara and 11 poster presentations. 38 people attended the Workshop. The best student presentation award will be given to Mr. Ali Therrien-Motamedi.
- d. **RM-2025** – M. Miller reported on this year's Reed-Muller workshop. The workshop was held on June 4, 2025. The number of submissions was 5, and all submissions were accepted. There were 1 invited talk and 2 regular sessions. The number of registrants is 24 (22 in person and 2 online attendees). There was no fee for the workshop. A refreshment break was funded by the Darwin Deason Institute for Cyber Security, Southern Methodist University. The workshop was successfully done. The next RM workshop will be held in Europe in 2027. M. Miller also suggested changing name of the workshop to attract attendees to the workshop. The committee members agreed to keep considering it until the next year's committee meeting.

### 3. Future Events

- a. **ISMVL-2026** – N. Homma reported that the 56<sup>th</sup> symposium would be held on May 19 to 21 in Sendai, Miyagi, Japan as approved at the 2024 Plenary Session. N. Homma will serve as the Symposium Chair. The collocated ULSIWS2025 will be held on May 18, excursion and banquet will be held on May 20 for now. The proposal was approved.
  - b. **ULSIWS-2026** – The workshop will be held just before ISMVL-2026 as usual. 1 invited talk and poster sessions are planning for now. R. Miyauchi will join as a General Co-Chair to the workshop committee. The committee members agreed the proposals.
4. **Site Proposal for ISMVL-2027 & ISMVL-2028** – H. Gundersen and S. Bos proposed hosting ISMVL-2027 in Kongsberg, Norway in May 2027. They said that Kongsberg is easily accessible from Oslo by train.  
The proposal was very well received.

As for ISMVL-2028, considering holding in USA is agreed. There was an opinion that Dallas might be a good candidate since ISMVL-2022 was held virtually, not in Dallas.

5. There being no other business, the meeting concluded at 12:35.
